One PhD bursary is available at the Kirstenbosch Research Centre (KRC), Cape Town. The student will be required to undertake a three-year research project at the KRC and register at any South African university.

Requirements: The bursary is available to black South Africans with good university grades and a lot of enthusiasm and initiative.

Value: The bursary is valued at R100 000 p.a. for three years, subject to satisfactory progress and is for living expenses and university fees. Project running expenses will be at the discretion of the supervisor. Please submit a budget, indicating co-funding, if you require support for operational costs. Applicants must be registered for or intend registering in 2012 for a PhD degree.

Available projects relate to key research programmes within the Applied Biodiversity Research Division.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications should include a detailed CV, certified copy of academic record and highest qualification, a letter of reference from an academic supervisor, and a letter motivating why the student should be considered for the bursary.
