

Through a generous donation from the Canon Collins Trust, the Durrell Institute of Conservation and Ecology (DICE) is able to offer one **fully funded studentship on our taught Masters in our Conservation Science and Management programme** to a suitable candidate from **Southern Africa**. The course would start in September 2013 and the deadline for submitting an application is **22.00 (GMT) on Sunday 3rd March 2013**. More details about the scholarship are given below.

Applicants must:

- be nationals of or have official refugee status in one of the following countries: Angola – Botswana – Lesotho – Malawi – Mozambique – Namibia – South Africa – Swaziland – Zambia – Zimbabwe
- have at least two years of work experience before applying for this scholarship
- be in possession of a good undergraduate degree, with a minimum grade of a 2:1, or equivalent
- be seeking funding for a full-time taught Masters programme at DICE

Scholarship details:

- The Scholarship cover full tuition fees, a monthly stipend, a return economy flight, a settling-in allowance and other support whilst in the UK.
- The scholarship is to undertake one of the following eight Taught Masters courses at DICE: Conservation & Business, Conservation & International Wildlife Trade, Conservation & Plant Science, Conservation & Primate Behaviour, Conservation & Rural Development, Conservation & Tourism, Conservation Biology or Conservation Project Management.

How to apply:

- 1) Identify a suitable Conservation MSc course from the School of Anthropology and Conservation (SAC) website - http://www.kent.ac.uk/sac/studying/pg_index.html
