Terms Of Reference for Modderfontein Environmental Education Officer

The Modderfontein Reserve is a private 275 hectare reserve located on the eastern side of Gauteng. One of the Modderfontein Reserve's key strategic imperatives is to conduct environmental education in the reserve and to align this environmental education with the national education curriculum. Modderfontein Reserve aims to become an environmental education centre that will be available to all learners in the surrounding areas to visit and learn about the environment in a natural environment.

An education centre has been revamped and is available for dedicated education activities. The Modderfontein Reserve seeks to employ an environmental education officer to run the education program. The specific responsibilities will include:

- Work in conjunction with the Modderfontein Reserve management team to enhance the education centre and make this venue suitable for education activities.
- Develop an environmental education curriculum that aligns with the national education curriculum for all grades.
- Visit and communicate with schools in the local area and market the education program to these schools.
- Arrange the logistics and run the education program during these school visits.
- Establish a Modderfontein Reserve environmental club and run the club.
- Report back to the Modderfontein Reserve management team and attend all relevant meetings.

The key qualifications and experience required for the position include:

- Relevant education related qualification.
- Minimum of 2 year education experience.
- Passion for the environment and conservation.
- Excellent communications and organisational skills.
- Knowledge of environmental issues and conservation.
- Willingness to work independently and as part of a team when required.
- Willingness to work in an isolated reserve environment on a daily basis.
- Drivers license and own transport required.
- Computer literate.
- PDP drivers license a benefit.
- FGASA qualifications a benefit.
- Second language would be advantages.
