The Department of Zoology invites applications for its 2015 Zoology honours programme. The minimum requirement is a BSc in the biological sciences with a 60% average in a zoology-related major. The course comprises a series of highly interactive lecture modules in Fieldwork Skills, Nature Conservation, Ecophysiology, Mammal Diversity, Aquatic Parasitology, Population Genetics / Biosystematics, Fish Histology / Pathology, Indices of Biotic Integrity and Biodiversity / Evolution. Students will also complete a research project in a field of their choice that fits within the research scope of the department. Our research strengths are in the fields of aquatic biology, physiology and molecular evolution. A maximum of 20 students are selected each year on the basis of academic merit.
